

Alert Messaging System (AMS)

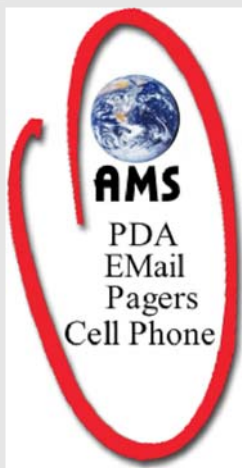
